

We are adding 148-17 that we were keeping to the sale. He is lot 100 but will be sold after lot one. We are going to use 87-18, 7.3kg 2yr old instead. He is by Joseph out of dam 45-14 who is an ET sister to 82-14 the dam of 3yr old 148-17. ET sisters 82-14, 77-14 and 45-14 are star performers. 148-17 is very quiet with 20 cm beam and 24 and 25cm above trez. We are still keeping his brother 145-17 on front cover.

This page of text was a hand out at our 2018 auction about Lot1 and his pedigree. Also relates to Lot100 - 148-17, added to 2021 sale after catalogue was printed.

Lot One

This stag has a very powerful velvet pedigree that I want to talk about.

Having hinds that produce sons good enough to be sold as sires is good but a hind that produces a son good enough to be used in the stud is a big step up.

His dam line and 152-01 mother of Victrix are mentioned a lot in the catalogue.

This dam line started when in 1988 we purchased 136-85. She was in fawn to a stag from Rob Brookes – She had a hind fawn, 23-88 who had a son that cut 5kg.

23-88 also had a daughter 9-90 and we used 2 of her sons in the stud.

9-90 is the dam of 67-92 and we used her son 106-96 in the stud. He was then sold as a trophy around the 400 mark.

67-92 is the dam of 46-95 who produced 2 sons used in the stud. 78-02 and 186-04. His head is on the wall. Both then sold as trophies around the 480 SCI.

46-95 is the dam of 152-01 with 3 sons sold as sires and one being Victrix – He was sold to Arawata as a 2yr old and has gone on to score 640 IOA @ 7yr and features strongly in Arawata's catalogue.

184-12 is the dam of lot one this year and is a full sister to Victrix – We used her son 177-14 last year at 2yr old and are using 34-14 her other son this year as a 3yr old.

This will mean we will have used two sires out of this dam too.

Lot 6 155-14 8.55kg and lot 9 47-14 9.85kg are out of another full sister to Victrix and hind 184-12.

Lot one Tag 177-14 was sired by Everest as a natural mating after using his dam as a Donor hind mated to Harlem. We are retaining one of her Harlem sons 34-14 who features on the back cover of the catalogue.

We used 177-14 as a 2yr old and with what I consider is the most powerful velvet pedigree you could find I think he will prove to be a top sire.

He is a late natural mating after an ET program to a 15 month hind.

He weighed 70kg as a weaner at the end of IV larch then went on to weigh 218kg at 3yr. Look at his spiker velvet with an incredible beam circumference of 22cm His velvet weight of 8.4kg could have been heavier as he was cut to get his head off in time for the Nationals.

All the above also applies to lots 6 and lot 9 with the only difference being lots 6 and 9 are both out of 207-12 an embryo sister to 184-12 the dam of lot one and the dam of Harlem son 34-14 that we are retaining.

207-12 and 184-12 have each produced in one year an incredible stag by an ET mating then they have each produced another incredible stag by a different sire from natural mating after ET.

The following hind lots are also out of the above dam line. Lots 41 44 49 58 60 83 85 87 93

Very powerful pedigree going back to hind 136-85.

We are including 148-17 in sale because we are going to use 87-18 7.3kg @ 2yr old Joseph son out of hind 45-14. She is another ET sister to 82-14, 77-14 and sire 34-14.

The other 2yr old we will use is Harlem son 106-18 7kg @ 2yr out of 295-15. She is a full sister of 177-14 lot one 2018 that the previous page is about.

This must be one of the strongest, if not the strongest dam line for consistently breeding top velvet sires.

When we as deer farmers use a new sire we have to wait 2 years to see the progeny's first proper velvet heads but with breeding like above behind them it gives confidence you will have a consistent, good hit rate.
