LOCATION

Forest Road Farm is located at 9km up Gwavas Road, Tikokino.

If coming from Napier we are 1 hour from the airport. Follow Highway 50 until you reach Gwavas Road which is on the right.

If coming from the South, we are approximately 45 minutes from Dannevirke and 20 minutes from the corner of State Highway 2 and State Highway 50.

Ignore road closed signs at start of Gwavas Road (road blew out in Cyclone Gabrielle) access around bollards and over old bridge for light vehicles and trailers under 3.5 tonne.





FOREST ROAD FARM

Well, what a year it has been in the Bay! 18 months of relentless rain caused country to slip that has never moved before with the onslaught of Cyclone Gabrielle. Apart from a massive gap where our road used to be and some scarring that will last years... I think its fair to say that we got off reasonably lightly compared to some of our Deer Farming peers in the region.

Cyclones aside, a lack of feed hasn't been an issue and the stock have wintered well and are in great condition. Velvet has harvested well, with weights up on last season and more importantly the sale animals are looking fantastic.

Its always a battle to get the catalogue out with enough time for clients to digest it before sale day on Friday 15th December. As I write this, we still have 25 out of 89 3-year stags to velvet! The 64 3yr stags we have cut to date average 6.4kg and it's been a tough job getting it down to 23. When we select our Sale Sires, we don't just select on velvet weight. These stags all have great temperament and good body size (some are huge). We are extremely proud of the style of velvet that we are producing here at Forest Road Farm, and feel it is the type and style that the market desires and we feel that the 3-year Sires and Yearling hinds are a great representation of this.

We are very excited to deliver the first 3-year Lazarus sons to market. Every Lazarus son we have cut has been very tidy (most SAP). The 5 Lazarus sons catalogued are a true representation of the style he is producing.

Even Stevens our Harlem son from Netherdale has been such a prolific breeder of tidy Sale stags, we decided a few years back to mate him over the line of Hinds we purchased from Cruse Deer, to produce a different outcross for breeders.... This has had a tremendous result as you can see from the style and weight of this cross in this year's offering.

Our new Sires are going ahead in leaps and bounds and we can't wait to see how they cross with our proven bloodlines.

Kryptonite has cut a massive 12.10kg @ 5yr and his beam is round and huge!




Irwin has produced a gorgeous, eye catching 9.10kg SAP @ 4yr that has just taken out the HB 4yr Red section plus Champion of Champions!

This year we have decided to only sell a handful of Elite yearling Hinds, that have been selected out of our keeper hinds. These Hinds are out of proven Dam lines and we see this as a great opportunity to focus in on some different Bloodlines that are highly regarded here.







Irwin has just taken out 1st place in the 2023 Hawkes Bay Velvet Competition (4yr Section) and been crowned Champion of Champions.






Hendricks @ 3yr @ 12.00kg

This year he has made a big jump to a massive 12.10kg @ 5yr.




Even Stevens 11.80kg @ 7yr






Brexit 8.90kg @ 6yrs







Forbes 9.30kg SAP @ 6yr


We bought Forbes as a 3yr old from Tom Cruse. He has a gorgeous style of velvet and grows a very eye-catching head. Unfortunately, we couldn't obtain a full pedigree for Forbes but he was a standout in his peers and with velvet having such a strong heritability.

I'm sure he will breed true to type and be a great outcross for us. Forbes's sire 490 cut 9.60kg @ 3yr then died. His grand sire 224 has been an amazing sire for Tom. Forbes won the 5yr Red Velvet Section in the 2020 Hawkes Bay Velvet Competition and placed 3rd in the NI. This year he cut a stunning 9.30kg head as a 6yr old. Forbes is now owned by Malcolm and Caroline Rau in Gisborne.



Omar is a stag we purchased as a package deal from Tom Cruse when we bought Forbes. Omar was a 4yr old at the time and 3 things really stood out to put him in the sire category. He is massive in size (matching up with Lazarus in the sire paddock), He has an extremely quiet temperament and last but most importantly he has a beautiful style of traditional dark velvet that weighs heavy!

At 4yr (in his first season with us), he broke a coronet fighting in the roar, so therefore grows deformed velvet on that side! This is such a shame as he has such beautiful style! Omar is now owned by Simone Hoskin.




HISTORY


T-Rex @ 10 yr

He breeds big bodied stags with very clean heavy velvet. T- Rex won the Hawkes Bay Open at 6 yrs old and placed 2nd in the North Island Velvet Competition Open, same year. He is the sire of Bonsai so also adds trophy to the mix if required.




Munta @ 8 yr

Munta was purchased as a 3yr old from the Rodway Park/Sarnia 2010 sale. He was already named due to his massive heavy beamed head. Munta won the North Island 4 yr Velvet Competition and went on to come 3rd in the National 4yr Velvet Competition. He breeds huge deer, not surprisingly as his dam clocked the scales at 140kg! He cut 10.5 kg SA velvet at 5yr and when trophied at 8 yrs, measured 496 IOA. He has been one of our most consistent velvet breeders.



Mortar 11.80kg @ 8 yr

Mortar has been the biggest in body and velvet weight of his year group from day dot. He is the most vigorous mating sire on the farm and achieves tremendous early conception rates. Mortar damaged one of his pedicles when he was young and as a result doesn't grow competition style velvet, but it's what he is leaving that counts.





We bred Bonsai here at Forest Road Farm and he was a standout from a spiker growing a massive 38 point spiker head. He was bred with velvet genetics and happened to grow a colossal trophy reaching 620 SCI @ 6yrs of age! Bonsai is leaving very dense correct velvet heads with big bulbs.
