Not often do stags turn out just how you pictured they would when you match a specific sire and dam together 3 years earlier, but this animal is just about spot on. You've got the Texas influence coming on in the royals with Rockafella/Dalla's style and scope. Bifurcating brows with good beys and tri trezs with kickers. Nice width with clean open royals.




0162 was 3rd in 2023 Rising stars 2yr section and scored 646 IOA. His full brother was 1st in the 1yr section with a record 682 IOA. Dam 15 5104 sister was sold Dec 2016 for \$55,000 and has produced Olympus 685 IOA @2 and 788 IOA @ 3 by Rigby for Peel Forest and Yankee 528 IOA @ 2 by Prometheus. Bifurcating brows, beys and trezs with matching kickers and huge tops and great aspect.


Extremely big scopey head, huge brows and treys and super wide. This is dam 17 717's first son and her half brother by Texas was our No.1 spiker of his year estimated to be over 600 IOA but with no competitions over Covid we cut him and unfortunately lost him.



Dam 10 0149 was purchased from Tower farms in fawn to Trump. Her son by fig jam purchased by Stu Henderson was super attractive. This stag has very good bottom tynes and excellent beam length. Royals just starting to split now.



Very strong tynes with treys splitting and fat beam, only just past velveting stage but a big royal bulb. Out of a first fawning dam, very quiet stag. Great grandam 12 252's full brother grown last year at 5 was 650 IOA, Reagan's 5yr son when hunting at over 950 IOA @ 5 this last season along with Nixon's top son 1000+ IOA.



Thick strong bottom tynes with big beam and double trey splitting with a kicker on the right. Good heavy royals coming with nice width to his head. Just the style you'd expect from the Kennedy Coco Amadeus cross. 0006 is a half brother to past sire Roman (661 IOA @ 4) who we still use by A.I



This guy has big treys and extra-long basals and a kicker on the left, multi T4s and royals just bursting. Out of a first fawning dam and proven repeatable performance from this bottom line.



This guy has a very inquisitive nature, nice clean bottom tynes with good spread and royals just starting to bulb up. This was 18 844 first fawn, grandam 14 473 also had a son by Lincoln cutting over 10kgs SA2 in the trophy mob.



Bifurcating brows with good length bey and trey tynes, only just past velveting but good royal bulb. Another out of a first fawning dam. Grandam 14 438 full sister produced a 5yr son by Reagan that was 950+ IOA this past season.





I yarded him by himself to cut his velvet and he trotted into the outside yard and then stood there and waited quietly while we open the shed. He walked in and into the crush where he stood and didn't move a muscle. Very thick beam and correct tyne placement with a round top.

Another very attractive Schiska son. Excellent bottom tyne placement and good length between bey and trez tynes and nice round beam above. Dam 18 835 half sister produced lot 9 Dec 19 by Watson, he also had a beautiful styed head that was 7.3kg SA2 at 3yrs and has gone on to cut 11.7 kg for Murry Templeton


0123 has produced an extremely correct dark head consistent with both his sire and dam's sire own velvet characteristics . This is 15 082 first male offspring.



The Texas Lincoln cross has produced mind blowing results with Navada - 2yr Rising stars champ @ 741 IOA @ 2. 20 0162 3rd 646 IOA also in the 2yr section and 21 1014 - 1yr Rising stars champ @ 682 IOA and a new record. The same cross also produced 2nd 1yr section and 4th which was 21 1024 full brother with 63 pts. Dam 19 927 is the first daughter from Zambuka's full sister which we jointly purchased for \$51,000. She was only one of four hinds A.ied here to the New No.1 Alonso which shows the high regard in which we hold her.



Bombay Sapphire over a half-sister to Purdy 950+ IOA. Dam 11 21's daughter by Texas sold Dec 22 for \$10K, she also has had daughters by Nixon and Kennedy since her purchase and now a fawn at foot again by Nixon. One of only two Bombay daughters born here last year. 22 2141 has a slight bend to her nose.



Unique cross with Purdy 900 + over the expansive Rockafella. 19 9150 full brother was lot 4 Dec 2019 and was yarded pre-sale for a client to view and unfortunately died the next day. He had an attractive 50-point head which we rated equal to Hennesay that was in the same sale. Dam 9150 first fawn a daughter by Texas, Grandam 13 339 only other son to date is a R2yr son by Morpheus.



Big structured heads of Boston and Kennery over the huge number of points from Leon! 18 833 first fawn a daughter by Cognac and second by Texas then 22 281. 15 515 first fawn was a stag by Nixon, Lot 6 - Dec 20 \$28K and has gone on to 700 IOA @ 5. She has had all daughters since by Nixon, Kennedy and Texas. Great grandam 12 236 has a son is named stroke defying all odds and growing a 600+ inch head in the trophy mob.


Trump captured the imagination of everybody who set eyes on him at 1yr of age with a massive spiker head that measured 630 IOA, weighing 13.2kgs. Trump is a full brother to Crowley Deer's Rockafella 639 IOA at 3yrs. Trumps full sister sold at 1yr of age for an industry record of \$55,000.






Stag 20 156 has a humongous mass of tynes, branches and points, in greater numbers on the right hand side compared to the left hand side. The left hand side has a strong bi straight brow, very long bez, short to heavy and splitting trez with dropper, then three heavy rows of royals. The right hand side has a birds beak brow, very strong bez, heavy trez with three rows of droppers behind each other, then heavy branches everywhere, possibly 19 - 20kgs in weight. Two half sisters by Trump have been sold(Hub Hall and Adventure Hunting).






Dam 15 5000 is now owned by Nick Cranston, along with her last daughter by Beauden. Head comments are, one down pointing brow, strong and long bez and trez, one splitting, very heavy beam to heavy royal split front to back. A very casual stag. Very heavy clean beam, wide velvet head.






20 206 is out of first fawning dam 18 8087. Comments are med brows, strong and long bezs, right hand side trez long splitting at end, with large splitting dropper off it. Left hand side double good trez, one plain dropper onto a mass of heavy royal points.






Stag 20 155 is the second offspring from dam 16 636, who is now owned by Neville Hamilton. Comments for 20 155 are, symmetrical upturning brow and bez, two snags, small dropper off right hand side trez, attractive round beam to large broccoli royal crown, not yet burst. Ben Hurr was an extra large cruisy stag with an extra large head, one side measuring just under 400 IOA four years ago.






Stag 20 182s head at this stage shows two straight brows, very long turning in bez's, heavy beam to heavy tri splitting trez's with plain droppers off each. Two rows of royal branches about to burst. We have two daughters by Dallas and Trump, retained.






Dam 17 7519 was a maiden 2yr hind, stag 20 192 being her first offspring. His head displays clean open bottom brow. Bez and trez, all good length, clean onto two rows of royals, branches are about to show points.






Head comments for 20 191 were one straight brow, the other has a birds beck, good length bez's, medium light beam to good trez's both with droppers and splitting, a strong large flat crown about to express points. Stag 20 192 is the only offspring we have on farm from 16 6072 before she left us. Grand dam 12 2024 was purchased by Nick Cranston, August 19.






Stag 20 166 has a super wide head, super long straight brows, 600 long, very long and strong bez and trez off long clean beam. Left hand side has a large circular royal formation about to break royals. Right hand side has a plain dropper above the right trez, but before the T4 a royal split goes sideways, eye catcher. 20 166 is the first and last offspring from dam 13 3256, who is no longer with us. Great grand dam 07 704 is a full sister to Crowley Deer's wonder hind 07 706.






Stag 20 16 is the second son from dam 15 5093 to cut over 6kgs of velvet at 3yrs. We have two daughters retained. Velvet removal notes were "Classic Gra", long and strong brow, bez and trez, round beam all the way, clean, one very small basal nob.






Stag 20 55 has two brothers cutting 7.3 and 6.7kgs in the velvet herd, and two daughters retained. Dam 12 210s daughter 21 181 selling to Glenfiddich Dec 22. Removal notes were, attractive, wide, dished head, symmetrical strong brow, bez and trez, good beam to fatter trumpet royal. A pen mate took a fair bit of hair off the back off 20 55 while we did machinery repairs outside shed pre cutting.






This is the third stag from 12 2046 to go to auction, her first in Dec 18 to Pat Garrett, 7.25kgs at 3yrs, and her second to Smedley Station, 6.8kgs at 3yrs. We have twin daughters retained by Totara. Super lamb in crush, freestanding, his head has straight brows, one birds beak, two basals, one straight bez, other med short, good round heavy beam to thick strong trezs, getting heavier to cut point.





Graham Johnson purchased dam 14 4025, Lot 37, July 23 for \$1600. Her first son is cutting 7kg in the velvet herd, her second son was Lot 9, Dec 20 sold to Frank Taylor for \$9000. We have two daughters retained by Schiska and Totara, and a weaner stag by Corona.






Dam 16 029s first fawn made Lot 4, Dec 21 to Ngatapa Station, we have retained two hinds since, by JD and Grafanarkis.






In my eyes this is a designer trophy hind, her offspring should not be expected to be a high IOA proposition, but the most attractive/eye catching/eye candy in any mob, near to 70 inch spread genetics from Discombe, King, Boston and Brusnik. From dam 17 784 we have three hinds retained.






Al yearling hind by Cruse 300, 12.4 kgs. Dam 15 031 is now owned by Graham Johnson, hind 22 2020 being her third offspring, we have as well a R2 and R3yr stag coming through the system.






Hind 22 247 is the second offspring from dam 19 983, who also has a R2yr stag on farm. We think very progressive velvet genetics here, Corona super quiet big stag, he and Podium are the only stags that we have the Newlands Crush up on Elk height, for big velvet to boot. Many 2yr sons averaging between 5 and 6 kgs, mixed with Grafanarkis style and temperament, topped off with class and style from Ramsey Reds.






Hind 22 2004 is the third of three daughters in a row from dam 18 8006. Grand dam 15 160 has given us four daughters, two to auction and two retained since we have owned her.





With Podium cutting a total of 23.43kg of velvet last year and 16.2kg this year we are frugal in parting with many hinds until numbers rise. On farm we have retained two hinds and a R2yr stag from dam 16 39. Progressive velvet genetics here with the class from Gus Schiskas' Ramseys Reds and Podiums velvet volume.





Hind 22 2021 is the fourth daughter from dam 17 723, grand dam 13 386 was purchased by Brock Deer Lot 30, July 18 for \$2500.
