This stag has exceptional velvet volume. Podium is big and black in body and velvet and very quiet to go with it. He grew a humongous 3yr head in structure, beam 32/27, 29/27, tynes and spread with very high trezs, short above, cut only four inches, 10 and 11cm above trez, with a thumb between the left trez and beam. The measure of any stag is "what they leave behind", the biggest two and three year heads on two farms, Crowley Deer and Tower Farms, by a country mile are PODIUMS.

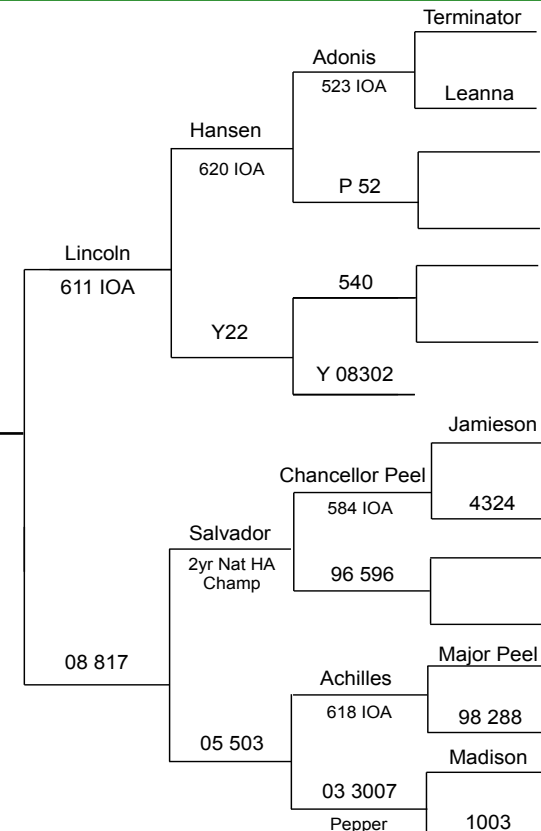
